#### **Ethics and Your Virtual Science Fair Project**

All projects involving human or animal research require specific approval from the FLASF ethics committee, prior to beginning any work on your project.

Students should review the documents relevant to their project to ensure their project adheres to these policies.

If the project involves any animal or human testing, the student must contact FLASF's Ethics coordinator at <a href="mailto:ethics@flasf.on.ca">ethics@flasf.on.ca</a>. Once approved, the student needs to complete all necessary documents, letters of permission for participants (if applicable), and required approval forms to <a href="mailto:ethics@flasf.on.ca">ethics@flasf.on.ca</a> one week before the fair or earlier. All hard copies must be available during judging.
